3. General

This Field Service Instruction provides guidance for replacing the current floor board screws (P/N NAS517-2-6) with shorter floor board screws (P/N NAS517-2-4).

4. Preparation

Remove the seats, carpeting, and heel rests, as necessary to access the floor boards (refer to the *KODIAK 100 Airplane Maintenance Manual*, Chapter 25).

5. Instructions

1. Using a screwdriver, replace all current floor board screws (P/N NAS517-2-6), including the hat shack area (zone 6) screws, with the shorter floor board screws (P/N NAS517-2-4).

A NOTE A

The washers should not need to be replaced, unless they are damaged. Contact Quest Aircraft if you require replacement washers.

- 2. Inspect the wiring harness for possible chaffing or wear from the original screws, paying special attention to the region where the wire bundle passes through the main gear area. If damage is found, contact Quest Aircraft for further instructions.
- 3. Clean the bilge area of any foreign objects or debris.

6. Completion

- 1. Reinstall the seats, carpeting, and heel rests (refer to the *KODIAK 100 Airplane Maintenance Manual*, Chapter 25).
- 2. Record all work performed in the appropriate maintenance records.
