SUBJECT: NOSE WHEEL STEERING, Mandatory Steering Bungee Inspection and Modification

#### **EFFECTIVITY:**

KODIAK 100 Series Aircraft Serial Numbers:

100-0001 through 100-0044

#### SUMMARY:

Quest Aircraft Company has received a single report that during a maintenance inspection of a KODIAK 100, excessive movement and play was found between the Steering Bungee Rod End Housing (*P/N 100-617-0147*) and the Steering Bungee Rod End (*P/N 100-617-0146*) with the Lock nut tightened to specifications.




Figure 1: Steering Bungee Inspection Location

# ACTION:

Quest Aircraft Company is mandating a one-time inspection and modification to check the Steering Bungee (*P/N 100-617-0140*) for movement in the area where the Steering Bungee Rod End Housing (*P/N 100-617-0147*) connects to the Steering Bungee Rod End (*P/N 100-617-0146*) (See **Figure 1**). The Steering Bungee modification (**FSI-018**) consists of installation of a Locking End Cap to the Steering Bungee.

Inspection and accomplishment instructions can be found in the next section of this Service Bulletin. The Steering Bungee Modification kit (FSI-018) can be ordered through Quest Aircraft Company Customer Care. There is no charge for FSI-018. If movement is found at the area of concern, do not operate the aircraft with this condition present and report the inspection

results immediately to Quest Aircraft Company Customer Care.

Steering Bungee (P/N 100-617-0140)

# FAA APPROVED:

The inspection and modification described in this Service Bulletin has shown compliance with the applicable Federal Aviation Regulations and is FAA Approved.

#### **COMPLIANCE:**

**Section 1** of this Mandatory Service Bulletin must be completed on or before the next <u>10 flight hours</u>. The Steering Bungee modification (FSI-018) **Section 2**, must be completed on or before the next scheduled maintenance, 100 hour inspection, or annual inspection, whichever occurs first.

# 1. SECTION 1: STEERING BUNGEE INSPECTION

## 1.1 STEERING BUNGEE INSPECTION

Inspect the Steering Bungee assembly (P/N 100-617-0140) using the procedure listed below.

### PROCEDURE:

- 1. Gain access to the Steering Bungee assembly (*P/N 100-617-0140*) using the procedures defined in the KODIAK 100 Maintenance Manual. Follow all safety precautions listed in the KODIAK 100 Maintenance Manual prior to accessing the Engine Compartment.
- 2. Inspect the Steering Bungee assembly (P/N 100-617-0140) for movement in the area where the Steering Bungee Rod End Housing (P/N 100-617-0147) connects to the Steering Bungee Rod End (P/N 100-617-0146) (See Figure 1):
  - a. Manually move the Steering Bungee in all directions at the area of concern noted in Figure 1. Observe for movement between the Steering Bungee Rod End Housing (P/N 100-617-0147) and the Steering Bungee Rod End (P/N 100-617-0146). There should be no relative movement between the two. If movement is found, the Steering Bungee Rod End Lock Nut should be verified for proper torque (reference the KODIAK 100 Maintenance Manual, 180-200 in-lbs). If relative movement is still found, contact Quest Aircraft for a replacement Steering Bungee assembly.

# 2. SECTION 2: FSI-018 STEERING BUNGEE LOCKING CAP INSTALLATION

# 1.2 COMPLETE THE STEERING BUNGEE MODIFICATION

 Once Section 1 is complete, perform the instructions in FSI-018 to modify the Steering Bungee within the time frame listed in the Compliance Section on Page 1. This modification installs a Locking End Cap to the Steering Bungee Rod End (P/N 100-617-0146) assembly.
